Quick Facts

New retail vehicle registrations increased an estimated 6% in February '15 vs. year earlier.

The area market was up 9.4% during the first two months of this vs. year earlier, stronger than the 3.6% increase in the Nation.


Area used vehicle market was up 8.3% in January '15 (vehicles seven years old or newer). Used vehicle registrations increased 6.7% for all of 2014.

Compact Luxury SUV new vehicle market share was up one share point in January.

Two year old used vehicle market share increased sharply, while six year old share declined.

Tesla, MINI, Lexus, Chrysler, Subaru, and GMC new retail registrations increased by more than 20% so far this year.



Change in Area Segment Market Share - January 2015 vs. January 2014




