**\*\* IMPORTANT \*\***  
**\*\* PLEASE READ IMMEDIATELY \*\***

Beginning August 1, 2019 all licensed vehicle dealers and auctioneers shall be required to stamp on all Illinois certificate of titles or rebuilt titles for vehicles that are sold for **less than \$5,000.00 and are less than 12,000 lbs** (does not include salvage or junk titles) to out-of-state dealers or out-of-state wholesalers in **36 point font**, on the front of the title and on the back in the reassignment area, with either of the following:

**“NOT FOR RESALE WITHIN ILLINOIS”**  
**Or**  
**“NOT FOR RETAIL SALE WITHIN ILLINOIS”**

No out-of-state dealer or wholesaler is permitted to sell direct to Illinois resident's within the borders of Illinois. Any vehicle sold to an out-of-state dealer or wholesaler that is sold directly to an Illinois resident will be investigated for failure to obtain an Illinois dealer's license.

In addition, no dealer or wholesale, whether licensed by Illinois or another jurisdiction, should be issued a temporary registration permit (TRP), 7-day permit, or a 30-day drive away permit. All vehicles sold to dealers and/or wholesalers should be removed from the dealer's or auctioneer's premises with dealer plates, in-transit plates, or by trailer.

Any new/used dealer or auctioneer licensee that is found violating the TRP/permit process shall be found in violation of the Illinois Vehicle Code and may be subject to administrative, such as a suspension or revocation of a vehicle auction license, or criminal penalties.
